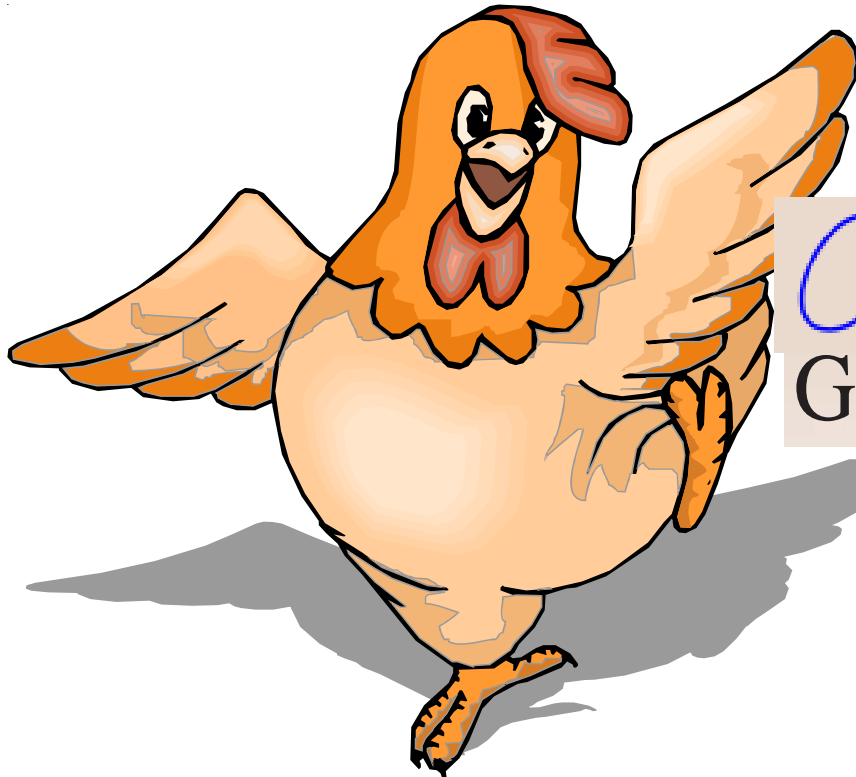

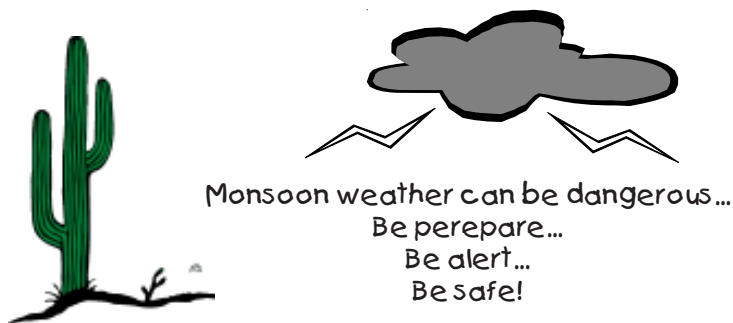

Manager's Corner

July, 2011

Summer is upon us and we are now basking in triple digits and watching our flowers crisp and die off. Temperatures get into the 150's inside of cars very quickly and only a few hardy souls are left in Venture Out during these dog days of summer. The only really positive thing you can say about summers in Arizona... is that it keeps us from having California's population issues! Current occupancy is 196 with eight renters in the park.

Work continues on the East Pool and we thank everyone for co-operating and sharing the west pool, just as we had to share the east pool last summer.

Palm tree trimming will start in July and in general takes a little over a month to complete the park. ACE asphalt will finish up the repaving of Helio and Fairchild this week. Seal coating will start a little later in the season. The roof on the Laundry/Ceramics/Sewing building was completely replaced in record time. Several other budgeted projects will start after July 1st when we are in the new fiscal year. Watch for photos of these projects online at both the web site and our new Venture Out Facebook page. I am posting a lot more videos and photos on Facebook than on the web site as it is very easy to do and is a medium that more and more people enjoy.

I want to thank Angel Moreno for helping me work on the new web site. It took eight weeks of more or less continuous work, to build this site and we still have some tweaking to do on it. We've had a lot of positive comments on it and people are finding it easier to navigate. If you haven't looked at it yet go to: www.ventureoutvresort.com and check it out.

The Bulletin Board is up and running again. The first day out of the chute we had some spammers hit us, so we had to shut it down and increase the security on it. The Board is for VO lot owners and renters to post on. Persons, who do not live in the park, are not able to post on the Board. The general public can READ the Board, just not post on it. It is already a large job for this office to keep track of thousands that can post on the Board, without opening it to the general public. When you register on the board for the first time, you will find the registration under "Member Login" at the very top of the page. If you don't see that, you are not at the top of the page! Please fill out the "Edit Profile" completely and use your VO address, which helps us to identify that you do reside in Venture Out. If we cannot identify you, you will not be authorized and cleared to post on the Board. This Board is more sophisticated and does allow you to post photos as well as place your ad, so have fun.

We are making the first payment to SRP for the transformers that were moved on July 1st. Many folks have forgotten that we did this work and have called and asked what this assessment was for. Again, SRP has decided to expand their survey and they are currently back in the park, marking the location of all the secondary and primary lines with their whisker pins or water soluble paint. When this work is done, we will have the most complete map of the park since it was built. This type of survey is very expensive and we are very lucky that SRP has decided to do this work. We are probably also benefiting indirectly from the construction slowdown in the state and that their crews have the time to do this work.

The offices will be closed on the Fourth of July Holiday. Have a wonderful Holiday and a great summer!
