

Venture Out Bocce Ball Guidelines

Following the Centers for Disease Control and Prevention (CDC) guidance, under all circumstances, the following precautions should be followed by people utilizing the facilities.

- Stay home if sick.
- Protect yourself while visiting the courts.
 - Stay at least 6 feet away from other patrons.
 - If you are at higher risk for severe illness, you should avoid visiting this facility. People at higher risk for severe illness include adults 65 or older and people of any age who have serious underlying medical conditions.
- Do not touch your eyes, nose, or mouth.
 - Do not enter the courts with a body temperature of 100 degrees F or more.
 - After entering and leaving the facility, use hand sanitizer. When you get home, wash your hands with soap and water for at least 20 seconds.

The following guideline are mandatory to ensure the well-being of Bocce Ball players.
Thank you for your cooperation.

- **Only VO residents are allowed to use the Bocce Ball facility.**
- Maintain physical distancing, to the extent possible.
- **All players are required to wear masks.**
- Bring your own water for drinking.
- A **maximum of 16** VO residents may be on the courts at one time.
- Benches will be marked for seating to maintain 6-foot separation. Only one person should be on the court throwing at a time. Players take a seat between shots. Opposing team is allowed a spotter down court to help determine distance scoring.
- Avoid changing ends of the court.
- There are TWO sanitization stations, one at each end. At the start and conclusion of play apply sanitizer on paper towels and wipe the balls, hand rail and benches. Wipe the score wedges at the end of play.
- Only use foot to move balls to end of the court following a turn. Do not touch balls of opposing team.
- Players are encouraged to leave courts as soon as possible following the game.
- At the conclusion of play for the day, players should place both sanitization carts in the clubhouse.
- **Only COURTS 2 and 4** are available for use.
- The Pickleball restrooms are open for washing hands, etc.
- Remember, if we don't enjoy Bocce according to these guidelines, Condo Board/Administration may terminate the use of the facility. All guidelines were created with the SAFETY of residents in mind.

The following action items are by members of BOCCE BALL.

- Vacuum and basic cleaning as needed to keep courts playable.
- Balls and scoring wedges should be secured in the storeroom and the end of play each day.
