

Venture Out Pool Room Guidelines

Following the Centers for Disease Control and Prevention (CDC) guidance, under all circumstances, the following precautions should be followed by people utilizing the facilities.

- Stay home if sick.
- Protect yourself while visiting the facility.
 - Stay at least 6 feet away from other patrons.
 - If you are at **higher risk for** severe illness, you should avoid visiting this facility. People at higher risk **for severe illness** include adults 65 or older and people of any age who have serious underlying medical conditions.
 - Do not touch your eyes, nose, or mouth.
 - Do not enter the facility with a body temperature of 100 degrees F or more.
 - After entering and leaving the facility, use hand sanitizer. When you get home, wash your hands with soap and water for at least 20 seconds.

The following guideline are mandatory to ensure the well-being of all players. Thank you for your cooperation.

- **Only VO residents are allowed in the facility.**
- Maintain physical distancing, to the extent possible.
- All players are required to wear masks.
- Bring your own water for drinking.
- A maximum of 10 VO residents may be in the facility at one time.
- No more than three players per table.
- Facility hours are limited to the hours of 8am to 5pm.
- Use sanitary wipes or spray provided to wipe the balls, rack, VO cues, table rails, and chairs before and after use.
- Twelve chairs have been placed to maintain the 6-foot safety requirements. Players should wipe down a chair that they use throughout the play, should a player move to a different table and use another chair it should be wiped down. Use only the chair you have wiped down, do not use chair cleaned by another player. Please do not move chairs, if necessary the benches can be used but only at the areas marked for seating.
- Players are encouraged to use their own cues and to adhere to the cleaning of them with sanitary wipes. Four VO playing cues and three breaking cues will be available for use.
- During play, one player will be designated as the ball handler. That player will use hand sanitizer, and then take the balls out of the pockets and rack them for the next game. No other player will touch the balls or racks. Ball handler shall handle all scratches by placing the ball so that other players can use the cue to final place the ball.
- Only Tables 1, 2 and 6 are available for use.

The following action items are by members of the Pool Room.

- Vacuum and basic cleaning on a regular two-week schedule.
- The remainder of the cues, chalk will be placed in the storeroom. The large fan and water dispenser will be covered and marked not for use.
